To be eligible for this scholarship the person must have at least a 2.5 GPA and be planning to attend a school of higher education: a four year college, a junior college, or a technical school. It is preferred that this person has an agricultural background or upbringing. \$500 will be awarded for each semester of the school year. Applicant must maintain a 2.5 GPA the first semester to get the \$500 for the second semester.

To apply for this scholarship you must fill out an application form and write a 100-150 word essay describing your background, hobbies, school activities, accomplishments, and future goals.
